Intention to align activities with other actions

This deliverable should contain a document expressing the intention to align communication activities and implementation plans with other actions addressing similar topics. The document should have been signed by the MAGPIE Coordinator and the coordinators of the other actions mentioned. For understandable reasons we have decided not to draft such a document, because it would no longer be relevant:

1. CINEA has provided us with the help of an organization known as Green Deal Support Office (GDSO). No signed document is needed in order to keep all projects involved and have them cooperate in not just communication and implementation, but with all subjects the Coordinators feel necessary. Also, the group of relevant projects is much bigger than what we had foreseen while signing the Grant Agreement and still expanding.
2. Only MAGPIE has mentioned the deliverable in the Grant Agreement. Since this is not obligatory to the other projects, it is better to leave the cooperation on a more informal basis.
3. We are still in the process of discussing with the other actions that were awarded in the Horizon 2020 call green deal for green (air)ports what we want to do exactly in terms of communication, dissemination, implementation, et cetera. With the PIONEERS action, we even consider sharing demo results and drafting a combined masterplan. Until this is completely clear, it would not be appropriate to sign a document that specifies our cooperation.
4. The intention was that the deliverable would be public. On second thought, Port of Rotterdam, as Coordinator of the MAGPIE action, does not find it appropriate to share with the public any document expressing the will to cooperate with the other actions and to which extent. Such a document would certainly contain classified information and therefore cannot be shared. If needed, we will file an amendment to remove the document from the Grant Agreement or alternatively, to change the status of public to confidential.
